This award is a classroom library, valued at over \$1000, which was created in 2006 through a generous gift to the Illinois Reading Council from (then) Senator Obama. This collection is comprised of carefully selected literature that is “culturally relevant” for African-American readers and targets students in the middle-school (5th-8th) grade range. This year the 2010 library will be awarded to a teacher in Aurora. Would you please help us identify a worthy recipient?

The 2007 inaugural award went to *Sharon Dodds* of Peoria who used her classroom library to bring great adolescent literature to her 8th-grade students.

You are especially qualified to make a nomination because:

- You teach or reside in Aurora, and
 - You are a member in good standing of the Illinois Reading Council.
- You do not need to be a teacher of middle-grade students to make this

nomination, **AND self-nominations are permitted and encouraged.**

The 2008 library was awarded to Cindy Morgan who teaches 5th-grade students at Lynne Thigpen Elementary School in Joliet

By completing a nomination you will be

- serving the Illinois Reading Council,
- helping an Aurora teacher bring culturally relevant literature to his or her students, and
- assisting the IRC in responding to President Obama’s challenge to “get more kids reading.”

Melissa Beckler won the 2009 library. She teaches 6th-8th graders at Washington Middle School in Springfield.
