Partner Reading in Content, Too**

Join Dr. Donna Ogle as she discusses *Partner Reading in Content, Too*, an instructional framework developed to support reading comprehension and fluency of nonfiction text. Dr. Ogle will discuss the progress and success of PRC2 currently implemented in urban and suburban classrooms and how this instructional framework helps ALL learners in the classroom with differentiated instruction in content reading. In addition, participants will have a chance to learn from teachers who will talk about implementation of PRC2 in classrooms grades K-8 with focus on text features, academic vocabulary, discussion and content reading. Research has shown this approach to be highly successful in middle school as well as elementary classrooms.

Participants may earn **one credit hour** by taking the course in conjunction with participation in the Suburban Council of the International Reading Association Conference. The course will meet Wednesday, February 24, 2010, from 4:30-10 pm and Saturday, February 27, 2010, from 8-5 (see below).

Participants will learn about:

- Developing reading and learning with informal texts
- The PRC2 framework
- Developing academic talk
- Providing guidance and structure
- Student change across time: A look at one 6th grade classroom
- PRC2 in a Primary Classroom
- Assessing students' interests, knowledge and concepts
- Teacher on-going assessment
- Using partner reading in guided reading
- Using literacy work stations to provide scaffolded learning
- Understanding external text features
- Academic vocabulary development
- Reinforcing vocabulary learning
- Creating lively, inquisitive conversation in the classroom

The course will be taught by Amy Correa and Margaret McGregor, teachers who will explicitly share their experiences in classroom management routines, guided reading groups, centers, and games and activities.
